To Whom It May Concern:

As the medical director of World Missions Possible, a Houston, Texas- based nonprofit that has provided free medical, surgical and disaster aid to 12 nations, I was searching for an ultrasound that our medical team could utilize in very rough conditions in small rural villages in West Africa. We needed a unit that was very durable, portable, lightweight, battery-operated, and could handle the extreme conditions of dust and heat out in the field.

When we first heard about the InnovaSound, we couldn't believe that we could find a portable ultrasound that would only weigh a few pounds. After we purchased the unit, we found the service from the salespeople to be excellent in that we received an upgrade (in the form of a flash drive) and easily downloaded the information to our laptop just days before we left for our trip. In the field, we found the unit to be reliable, easy-to-use, and having good image quality and clarity. It proved especially valuable in the evaluation of an anterior cervical neck mass, as well as the in evaluation of the fetuses in pregnant women. Many of our clinics in these villages are conducted outdoors or in very inadequate, open-air shelters. But due to the portability of the unit, it was easy and convenient to move and utilize the unit in tight areas, such as the back seat of our van.

I would recommend the InnovaSound unit to other mission teams and medical personnel active in field operations. It has proven to be a reliable and user-friendly diagnostic tool for our team.
